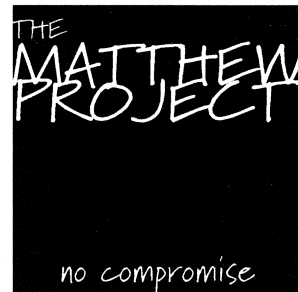

RE: SKYDIVE

It is really important that you are medically well to take part in the activity and that the company you use to skydive is accredited to train, help and advise you regarding the risks. If you have any doubts about fitness I would advise that you seek advice from a GP. In relation to insurance, the skydiving company should advise you what cover is available. Sky dives are definitely undertaken on a voluntary basis with the sky dive company and any injury or accident is outside our control.
